

Heather Downie

Heather has always had a love of Scottish music and has been singing for as long as she can remember. Her passion grew while working with the late Martyn Bennett, after which she decided that a career in traditional music would be her goal. At the age of 15, Heather began playing the Scottish harp and was immediately accepted into Splore, the traditional music course at the Aberdeen International Youth Festival. Having graduated in 2008 with a first class honours degree from The Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama, studying harp with Wendy Stewart and piano with Mary McCarthy and James Ross, Heather went on to complete a postgraduate diploma in Scottish music performance under the guidance of Corrina Hewat. A finalist in the BBC's Young Traditional Musician of the Year in 2015, Heather has travelled extensively in Scotland and her music has taken her as far afield as Germany, Denmark, Latvia and New York, playing for dignitaries such as Jack McConnell and Prince Albert of Monaco. She also provided backing for Tom Conti's rendition of A Man's Man during Tartan week in America in 2006, returning there in 2009. Heather also has an interest in composition and Scottish history, folklore and the roots of the songs and tunes in her repertoire. With more than ten years teaching experience both in schools and with individual pupils, Heather currently lectures at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland.

Ers erioed mae Heather wedi caru cerddoriaeth o'r Alban a dydy hi ddim yn cofio adeg pan nad oedd hi'n canu. Tyfodd ei hangerdd tra'n gweithio gyda'r diweddwr Martyn Bennett, ac ar ôl hyn penderfynodd mai ei huchelgais fyddai gyrfa mewn cerddoriaeth traddodiadol. Pan yn 15 oed, cychwynnodd ganu'r delyn Albanaidd ac fe'i derbyniwyd ar unwaith i Splore, y cwrs cerddoriaeth traddodiadol yng Ngŵyl Ieuencid Rhyngwladol Aberdeen. Graddiodd yn 2008 gydag Anrhydedd dosbarth cyntaf o Academi Cerdd a Drama Brenhinol Yr Alban, ble roedd wedi astudio'r delyn gyda Wendy Stewart a'r piano gyda Mary McCarthy a James Ross; yna aeth ymlaen i gwblhau diploma ôl-radd mewn perfformio cerddoriaeth Albanaidd dan gyfarwyddyd Corrina Hewat. Llwyddodd i gyrraedd rownd derfynol Cerddor Traddodiadol Ifanc y BBC yn 2015, ac mae hi wedi trafaelio'n eang yn Yr Alban ac mae ei cherddoriaeth wedi ei chymryd mor bell â'r Almaen, Denmarc, Latfia ac Efrog Newydd, yn chwarae i bwysigion fel Jack McConnell a'r Tywysog Albert o Monaco. Mae hi hefyd wedi darparu cerddoriaeth wrth gefn ar gyfer fersiwn Tom Conti o A Man's Man yn ystod wythnos Tartan yn America yn 2006, gan ddechrelyd yno yn 2009. Mae gan Heather hefyd ddiddordeb mewn cyfansoddi, a hanes a chwedloniaeth Yr Alban, a gwreiddiau'r caneuon a'r tonau yn ei repertoire. Gyda mwy na deng mlynedd o brofiad addysgu mewn ysgolion a chyda disgyblion unigol, ar hyn o bryd mae Heather yn darlithio yng Nghonservatoire Brenhinol Yr Alban.



Natasha Gale

Natasha Gale is a young professional harpist from Kent who graduated from The Royal Birmingham Conservatoire and studied under Gabriella Dall'olio, Catherine White and Eleanor Turner. Natasha has performed as a solo and orchestral harpist around Birmingham and in London and the West Country, playing frequently with the

Wolverhampton Symphony Orchestra and the Cheltenham Symphony Orchestra. She is currently harp tutor for several schools in the Cheltenham area and the Cotswolds, including Cheltenham College and Dean Close School, and is part of The Abrazo Duo with flautist Ellena Taylor. From her work in the UK Harp Association co-organising the Wild Strings pop and harp festival in 2018, Natasha discovered a passion for finding new ways of teaching new harpists, experimenting with jazz and pop harp, and exploring the full range of what is possible on the harp.

Telynores broffesiynol ifanc yw Natasha Gale o Swydd Caint a raddiodd o Gonservatoire Brenhinol Birmingham ble astudiodd dan Gabriella Dall'olio, Catherine White ac Eleanor Turner. Mae Natasha wedi perfformio fel telynores unigol ac mewn cerddorfa o amgylch Birmingham ac yn Llundain a Gorllewin Lloegr, yn chwarae'n aml gyda Cherddorfa Symffoni Wolverhampton a Cherddorfa Symffoni Cheltenham. Ar hyn o bryd mae hi'n diwtor telyn mewn sawl ysgol yn ardal Cheltenham a'r Cotswolds, yn cynnwys Coleg Cheltenham ac Ysgol Dean Close; mae hi hefyd yn rhan o'r Abrazo Duo gyda'r fflwytydd Ellena Taylor. O'i gwaith yng Nghymdeithas Telynau'r DU yn cydlynu'r ŵyl pop a thelynau Wild Strings yn 2018, darganfyddodd Natasha angerdd dros ddod o hyd i ffyrdd newydd o addysgu telynorion newydd, arbrofi gyda thelyn jazz a pop ac archwilio'r ystod lawn o'r hyn sy'n bosibl ar y delyn.

Claire Jones

Britain's best-selling classical harpist, Claire Jones was born in Wales. Following her appointment as Official Harpist to His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales (2007-11), she became a household name for her esteemed performance at the Royal Wedding of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge.

Solo career highlights include solo and concerto appearances with the world's top orchestras and artists such as the English Chamber Orchestra, Philharmonia Orchestra, Mariinsky Theatre Ballet Orchestra, Zurich Chamber Orchestra, London Mozart Players, Philharmonia, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, Sir James Galway, Maestro Gergiev, Joshua Bell, Renée Fleming, Sir Neville Marriner, Sir Bryn Terfel, and Alfie Boe to name only a few. She has performed prestigious recitals at Wigmore Hall and Cadogan Hall (London), Capitol Hill (USA), City Hall (Hong Kong), International Harp Festival (Brazil) and at the Millennium Stadium for an audience of 75,000.

Claire is no stranger to the classical charts with her albums *Girl With The Golden Harp*, *Journey*, *Highrove Suite*, and *This Love Reaching the Top* of the classical charts. Claire is a firm favourite on Classic FM playlists and her albums have been released worldwide.

Claire has a first class BMus(hons) degree from The Royal College of Music and studied as an MA (Scholar) at the Royal Academy of Music, London. In 2016 she was awarded an honorary Associateship from the Royal Academy of Music for her significant contribution to her profession, and is an international ambassador for jewellery company Clogau.



Ganed Claire Jones yng Nghymru a hi yw'r delynores glasurod sydd wedi gwerthu mwy o ddisgiau na neb. Yn dilyn ei hapwyntiad fel Telynyores Swyddogol i'w Uchelder Brenhinol Tywysog Cymru (2007-11), daeth yn enw adnabyddus i bawb am ei pherfformiad clodwif yn mhriodas Dug a Duges Caergrawnt.

Mae uchelfannau ei gyrfa yn cynnwys ymddangosiadau unigol a chonsierto gyda phrif gerddorfeidd ac artistiaid y byd megis Cerddoria Siambur Lloegr, Cerddoria Philharmonia, Cerddoria Bale Theatr Mariinsky, Cerddoria Siambur Zurich, Chwaraewyr Mozart Llundain, Philharmonia, Cerddoria Frenhinol

Philharmonig, Syr James Galway, Maestro Gergiev, Joshua Bell, Renée Fleming, Sir Neville Marriner, Syr Bryn Terfel ac Alfie Boe i enwi ond ychydig. Mae hi wedi cynnal datganiadau llawn bri yn Neuaddau Wigmore a Cadogan (Llundain), Capitol Hill (UDA), Neuadd y Ddinas (Hong Kong), Gŵyl Ryngwladol y Delyn (Brasil) ac yn Stadiwm y Mileniwm i gynulleidfa o 75,000.

Nid yw Claire yn ddieithryn i'r siartiau clasurod gyda'i disgiau *Girl With The Golden Harp*, *Journey*, *Highrove Suite*, a *This Love* yn cyrraedd brig y siartiau clasurod. Mae Claire yn un o hoff artistiaid Classic FM ac mae ei disgiau wedi eu rhyddhau ar draws y byd.

Enillodd Claire Radd BMus (Anrhydedd) dosbarth cyntaf o'r Coleg Cerdd Brenhinol ac astudiodd fel (Sgolor) MA yn Academi Cerdd Frenhinol Llundain. Yn 2016 dyfarnwyd iddi Cyd-ddarlithyddiaeth anrhydeddus gan yr Academi Cerdd Frenhinol am ei chyfraniad sylweddol i'w phroffesiwn, ac mae hi'n llysgennad rhyngwladol i'r cwmni gemwaith Clogau.

Chris Marshall from Cardiff has performed extensively as a percussionist specialising in World music; he has appeared and recorded with many prestigious orchestras and artists, and has performed on numerous productions in London's West End.

Chris balances his performance schedule with his flourishing career as a composer and arranger. His growing portfolio of compositions includes the music for *Heartstrings* (no. 1 download on iTunes) which was recorded for Classic FM/Decca in 2012 and was featured on Claire Jones' album *Girl With The Golden Harp*. Chris has composed *Bluestone* and arranged many tracks on Claire's chart-topping album *Journey*. In addition, Chris has composed music for TV adverts including a track for Clogau, shown internationally, and for *Fishermans Friends* currently showing in the USA. He is working on the next TV advert for Clogau to be released later in the year.

Mae Chris Marshall o Gaerdydd wedi perfformio'n helaeth fel offerynnwr taro sy'n arbenigo mewn cerddoriaeth y Byd; mae wedi ymddangos ac wedi recordio gyda llawer o gerddorfeidd ac artistiaid eithriadol ac wedi perfformio ar nifer o gynrychiadau yn West End Llundain.

Mae Chris yn cydbwysio ei amserlen o berfformio gyda'i yrfa lwyddiannus fel cyfansoddwr a threfnydd. Yn ei bortffolio cynyddol o gyfansoddiadau ceir y gerddoriaeth ar gyfer *Heartstrings* (lawrlwythiad rhif 1 ar iTunes) a recordiwyd ar gyfer Classic FM/Decca yn 2012 ac a nodweddiwyd ar albwm Claire Jones *Girl With The Golden Harp*. Cyfansoddodd Chris *Bluestone* a threfnu llawer o draciau ar albwm boblogaidd Claire *Journey*. Yn ogystal, mae Chris wedi cyfansoddi cerddoriaeth ar gyfer hysbysebion teledu yn cynnwys trac i Clogau, a ddangoswyd yn rhyngwladol, ac ar gyfer *Fishermans Friends* a welir ar hyn o bryd yn UDA. Mae'n gweithio ar yr hysbyseb teledu nesaf i Clogau i'w rhyddhau nes ymlaen yn y flwyddyn.

Yn 2017 fe'i comisiynwyd i drefnu ac arwain albwm newydd.

In 2017 he was commissioned to arrange and conduct a new album with the Portuguese singer sensation, Yolanda Soares, with whom he has performed recently with at the Tivoli Theatre Lisbon and Coliseum in Porto. He has also been commissioned by the American Youth Harp Ensemble and Choir to compose a special set of works which will be premiered on PBS television in the USA and at Carnegie Hall in 2020.

Chris' career highlights as a percussionist include appearing with the BBC Symphony Orchestra, English National Ballet, London Mozart Players, The Royal Shakespeare Company and the BBC National Orchestra of Wales. Chris has worked on many productions in London's West End and international touring shows in the UK and China; these include: We Will Rock You, Wizard of Oz, Zorro, Carousel, West Side Story, Evita, Love Beyond, Big, and Elf the Musical.

Chris has a passion for playing instruments from all around the world, which has resulted in his performing on numerous recording sessions for TV and film. He also performs as part of C2 duet with his wife, and former Official Harpist to HRH Prince Charles, Claire Jones. This unique duo has travelled extensively throughout the UK and in the USA.

Isabelle is invited to perform at the most famous halls and festivals, for example in New York, Amsterdam, Moscow, London, Frankfurt, Paris, Nantes and Caracas. She has performed as a soloist with the Bavarian Radio Symphony Orchestra, the Southwest German Radio Symphony Orchestra, the Orchestre de Chambre de Lausanne, the Orchestre de Chambre de Paris, the Warsaw National Symphony Orchestra, and many more.

Isabelle loves working with her chamber music partners Juliette Hurel, Magali Mosnier, François Leleux, Henri Demarquette, and with the Parisii, Ebène, and Hermès string quartets. Especially dear to her heart is her duo with Dame Felicity Lott: their disc Cantare continues to be a great success.

Highly-committed to expanding the repertoire of her instrument, Isabelle has inspired composers such as Philippe Hersant, Bruno Mantovani, Michèle Reverdy, Thierry Escaich, and Thierry Pécou to write for her.

Isabelle Moretti's rich and varied discography is warmly-praised by the media and critics alike.

An impassioned teacher, Isabelle Moretti gives masterclasses throughout the world, and teaches at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de la Musique et de la Danse de Paris (CNSMD). She is also Visiting Professor at London's Royal Academy of Music.

Isabelle is an Officer of the French National Order of Merit and Officer of the Order of Arts and Letters.

Caryl Thomas

Caryl Thomas heads the exciting and thriving harp department at The Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama in Cardiff, home of the 2020 Congress. Caryl made her American debut in 1981 at Carnegie Hall, New York; her London debut at the Wigmore Hall a year later; and has performed to critical acclaim throughout the UK, Europe, the USA and the Far East. She graduated from the Welsh College of Music and Drama and gained a Master's degree from New York University; her teachers were Ann Griffiths, Marisa Robles, Pearl Chertok and Susan McDonald. At 17 years old, Caryl was the first British harpist to win a major prize at the International Harp Congress in Jerusalem, and in 1993 was invited to give a solo recital at the World Harp Congress in Copenhagen.

Caryl performed as concerto soloist with the London Philharmonic, the BBC National Orchestra in Wales, the Bournemouth Sinfonietta and the Orchestra of St John's Smith Square, and appeared twice as concert soloist with the Mozarteum Orchestra in the Grosses Festspielhaus in Salzburg. During a period as harpist with the London Philharmonic, Caryl worked with eminent conductors such as Sir Simon Rattle, Klaus Tennstedt, Leonard Slatkin, Sir Bernard Haitink and Sir Charles Mackerras, and played the Bartok Festival at the Royal Festival Hall under the baton of Sir George Solti.

Caryl's discography includes the Mozart Flute and Harp Concerto with the London Philharmonic, a solo recital entitled Clair de Lune, and a collection of chamber works with the Prometheus Ensemble named French Impressions. Her broadcasting work includes recitals for Radio 3 and three series of her own television programme for S4C.

In 2007, Caryl was Artistic Director of the 7th European Harp Symposium and in June 2016 sat on the jury of the 10th USA International Harp Competition. Caryl is a member of the board of directors of the World Harp Congress.
