Evelyn Huber studied with Helga Storck at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater in Munich. She subsequently also taught there from 1998 to 2009, and in 2007 was appointed Visiting Professor at the Guildhall School of Music in London.

Evelyn began early on to cross conventional musical boundaries, exploring all the possibilities presented by the concert harp. Jazz workshops in the United States, concert activities with various ensembles around the world and her solo performances have made her a virtuoso in the genres of jazz and world music.

Evelyn Huber was a member of the Quadro Nuevo ensemble for many years, "Live Act of the Year" at the German Music Awards in 2010 and again in 2011.

Evelyn Huber has also been the recipient of a number of prestigious awards, including the Bavarian Cultural Award, and the Jazz Award of the German Phonographic Industry a number of times.

Her discography, with a huge variety of musical combinations, also evidence the vast scope of Evelyn Huber's unique artistry on the harp.
