The Belgian harpist/vocalist Pia Salvia is a unique artist in the modern harp world. Born in Brussels, she began playing the classical harp at the age of 7 and quickly decided to dedicate her career to exploring the harp. A graduate of Berklee College of Music in Boston, she has travelled extensively, exploring different musical traditions and creating a new and contemporary sound. Her music fuses pop, world music, and a jazz flavour.

Pia Salvia has been invited to perform at numerous festivals such as the Camac Harp Festival in France, Festival Mundial del Arpa in Paraguay, Vancouver Island Musicfest in Canada, Festival Internacional Arpa Sentmenat in Spain, Encuentro Internacional Maestros del Arpa in Colombia, Boston Harp Festival in the United States, Gaume Jazz Festival in Belgium, and many more. Recently, after living and performing for some years in New York, Pia has returned to her native Belgium. She currently teaches pop & jazz harp at the Royal Conservatory of Liège, and performs live, presenting the personal compositions from her latest album "Blissful Sigh" and many captivating arrangements.

Pia is accompanied by drummer, percussionist and producer Noam Israeli, also a graduate of Berklee College of Music in Boston. Together, they emphasise all the textures and emotions created by their blend of harp, vocals and percussion.
