Klervi Rouyer (Celtic harp) and Malo Le Gall (wooden flute) are a young modern trad duo. Both began playing traditional Breton music as small children - Klervi started the harp at the age of 5, while Malo began his musical life playing the bagpipes in a band in the northern Finistère region. Both also went to Breton-medium schools (Diwan), before continuing at the Brest Conservatoire of Music. The duo are regular guests at folk music festivals in Brittany and further afield.

Klervi, now studying traditional music in Rennes, is the first prize winner of our "Dasson an Delenn" Breton music competition, which last took place in 2019.
