Veronika Lemishenko began her harp studies with Larysa Klievtsova, in her native city of Kharkiv, Ukraine. She subsequently studied with Milda Agazarian and Mara Galassi. Veronika is Principal Harpist with the National Symphony Orchestra of Ukraine, and until early 2022 was Principal Harpist of the Ural Philharmonic.

Veronika is a prizewinner of international harp competitions in France, Spain, the United Kingdom, Ukraine, Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Russia, Greece and Singapore. As a soloist, she has been invited by festivals such as the Folle Journée de Nantes (France), the HarpMasters Festspiele (Switzerland), the Lisboa Harp Seminar (Portugal), and many others. In 2018, she gave her London debut recital at the Royal Academy of Music, and she is also a member of the Board of Directors of the World Harp Congress.

Her discography includes a CD of works by Jean-Michel Damase in collaboration with Chantal Mathieu, and two solo recordings.

Veronika is the Artistic Director of the international Glowing Harp festival and competition, which she founded with Larysa Klievtsova in Kharkiv to encourage young talent. This project has also given rise to the Veronika Lemishenko Charity Foundation. Since the war broke out, the Foundation has been fundraising for the war effort.
