Deborah Henson-Conant

Deborah Henson-Conant is a GRAMMY®-Nominated composer, performer, singer, songwriter, storyteller and the legendary "DHC" behind the "DHC" electric harp from CAMAC Harps. She's performed throughout the world, opened for Ray Charles at Tanglewood, toured as a rock harpist with guitarist Steve Vai and debuted her own original concertos with orchestras like the Boston Pops and the Pittsburgh Symphony. She's the harpist your parents never warned you about - the world's premiere electric harpist - and she straps on her harp, uses a looper pedal to create rhythmic soundscapes - then sings and plays music from Blues to Flamenco, telling stories from her life and travels. Gabriella Dall'Olio

Gabriella Dall'Olio has inspired audiences with solo recitals and chamber music concerts throughout the world and has gained considerable international recognition and prizes. She has two highly-acclaimed solo CDs to her name on the Claves label as well as concertos, duos and chamber ensemble CD recordings. McMillan chamber CD was no.1 in the classical charts in the UK last year, and her Solo Recital on Claves won the critics' prize and 5 Diapason when released and hailed as '75 minutes of poetry.' Gabriella commissions and premieres new works and collaborates with leading composers. She recently recorded Tafreshipour's Concerto for harp and orchestra with the English Chamber Orchestra, which will be released later this year on Naxos. Gabriella collaborates regularly with some of the world's finest orchestras and conductors, such as the Chamber Orchestra of Europe, London Symphony Orchestra, Royal Opera House and the Berliner and Wiener Philharmonikern, under the batons of Janssens, Mazel, Gergiev, Sir Colin Davis, Harnoncourt, Abbado, etc. Gabriella is a passionate and committed teacher and is Head of Harp Studies at Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Drama, where she trains young generations of musicians for a demanding and rewarding profession. Gabriella studied harp in Italy, Germany and France with Pierre Jamet, Jacqueline Borot, Fabrice Pierre, Anna Loro and Giselle Herbert.



Shelley Fairplay



Shelley Fairplay is a performer and teacher with over 15 years' experience teaching harp, harp ensembles and workshops for all ages. Her concert series The Three Strands: Passion, Sorrow and Joy was premiered in the UK in 2014, and her CD of the same name was released in 2015. Shelley's latest concert series HarpOSphere features her own

original works along with her arrangements of popular, classic and traditional tunes. Her concerts include traditional playing alongside performances on electric harp with effects pedals including the popular looper. She has performed throughout the UK, and appeared in Europe and the USA as a soloist and alongside internationally renowned harpists including electric jazz harpist Deborah Henson-Conant. Her Dynamic Harps ensemble features both an adult and children's group, filled with harpists who enjoy learning and performing music from films, pop, shows, classical, jazz and Celtic genres. 2016 saw the launch of her brand new online harp courses for beginner harpists, START HARP. The three courses total 36 weeks of tuition on technique, note reading, improvisation and playing by ear taught via teaching videos, play-a-longs, sheet music, live online Q&A's and video homework submissions from students. The courses have (so far!) taught harpists in the UK, mainland Europe and across the pond in Canada and the USA.

Mae Gabriella Dall'Olio wedi ysbrydoli cynulleidfaedd gyda datganiadau unigol a chyngherddau cerddoriaeth siambr ledled y byd ac wedi ennill gwobrau a chydubyddiaeth rhywgladol sylweddol. Mae ganddi ddwy CD unigol gafodd ganmolaieth uchel ar label Claves yn ogystal â recordiadau consiertos, deuawdau ac ensemble siambr. Roedd CD siambr McMillan yr rif 1 yn y siartiau clasurol yn y DU llynedd, ac ennilodd ei Solo Recital ar Claves wobr y beirniad a phan ryddhawyd 5 Diapason a honwyd ei fod yn '75 munud o farddoniaeth'. Mae Gabriella yn comisiynu ac yn chwarae gweithiau newydd am y tro cyntaf ac yn cydweithio â chyfansoddyr blaenllaw. Yn ddiweddar recordioli Concerto i'r delyn a cherddorfa gan Tafreshipour gyda'r English Chamber Orchestra, a ryddheir nes ymlaen eleni ar Naxos. Mae Gabriella'n cydweithio'n rheolaidd â rhai o gerddorfeydd ac arweinwyr gorau'r byd megis Cerddorfa Siambr Ewrop, Cerddorfa Symfoni Llundain, Y Ty Opera Brenhinol a'r Philharmonikern yn Berlin a Fiena, dan faton Janssens, Mazel, Gergiev, Syr Colin Davis, Harnoncourt, Abbado, ac ati. Mae Gabriella yn addysgwyr ymroddedig sy'n teimlo'n grif am ei phwnc ac mae'n Bennaeth Astudiaethau'r Delyn yn y Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Drama, ble mae hi'n hyfforddi cenedlaethau ifanc o gerddoriion i fynd i broffesiwn llawn gofynion ond gwerth chweil. Astudiodd Gabriella y delyn yn yr Eidol, yr Almaen a Ffrainc gyda Pierre Jamet, Jacqueline Borot, Fabrice Pierre, Anna Loro a Giselle Herbert.

Mae Shelley Fairplay yn berfformwraig ac athrawes gyda dros 15 mlynedd o brofiad yn addysgu'r delyn, ensemblau telyn a gweithdai i bob oed. Cafodd ei chyfres o gyngherddau The Three Strands: Passion, Sorrow and Joy ei pherfformio am y tro cyntaf yn y DU yn 2014, a rhuddhawyd ei CD o'r un enw yn 2015. Mae cyfres cyngherddau ddiweddaraf Shelley HarpOSphere yn dangos ei gweithiau gwreiddiol ei hun ynghyd â'i threfnianau o donau poblogaidd, clasurol a thraddodiadol. Mae ei chyngherddau'n cynnwys chwarae traddodiadol ochr yn ochr â pherfformiadau ar delyn drydan gyda phedalaeth ag effeithion yn cynnwys y 'looper' poblogaidd. Mae wedi perfformio ar draws y DU ac wedi ymddangos yn Ewrop a'r Unol Daleithiau fel unawdyyd gyda thelynorion sy'n enwog yn rhywgladol yn cynnwys y delynores jazz Deborah Henson-Conant. Mae ei ensemble Dynamic Harps yn amlyu grŵp i blant ac oedolion, gyda thelynorion sy'n mwynhau dysgu a pherfformio cerddoriaeth ffilm, pop, sioe, clasurol jazz a Cheltaid. Wleiddol 2016 lansiad ei chrysiau telyn newydd ar-lein, START HARP, ar gyfer telynoriion sy'n cychwyn. Ceir 36 wythnos o ddysgu am dechneg, darllen nodau, chwarae'n fyrfyfyr a chwarae â'r glust wedi eu haddysgu trwyideos, chwarae ynghyd, cerddoriaeth a bapur, Cwestiynau ac Ateb byw ar-lein a chyflwyniadau gwath cartref ar fideo gan fyfyrwyr. Mae'r cyrsiau (hyd yma!) wedi addysgu telynoriion yn y DU, Ewrop ac ar draws y môr yng Nghanada ac UDA.

Ben Creighton Griffiths

Ben Creighton Griffiths is an internationally performing harpist based in Cardiff. Although classically trained, Ben is in increasing demand for his electro-acoustic jazz harp work, covering many different genres and extensively using electronics to create unique performances. Ben's engagements include performances in Brazil, Canada, the Caribbean, Croatia, Czech Republic, France, Hungary, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain. Closer to home, Ben has performed as a soloist at the Edinburgh International Harp Festival, Wales International Harp Festival, Summer Harp Festival, Monmouth Festival, Ludlow Festival, Trinity Harp Festival, Derbyshire Harp Festival, Cardiff Camac Harp Weekend, East Anglia Harp Festival, Wall2Wall Jazz Festival, Cambridge Jazz Festival, Harp on Wight, Glasbury Arts Harp Summer School and the Vale Jazz Festival. Performances this year will include the World Harp Congress in Hong Kong, New Orleans Jazz & Pop Harp Weekend, and performances and tuition across Tennessee, USA. Ben releases his third studio album (1 Man Band) in February 2017 and will perform and record with Adrien Chevalier and Tatiana Eva Marie, members of Avalon Jazz Band from New York City.

Mae Ben Creighton Griffiths yn delynor sy'n perfformio'n rhyngwladol ac yn byw yng Nghaerdydd. Er iddo gael hyfforddiant glasurol mae Ben ar alw'n gynyddol i berfformio ei waith jazz electro-acwstig, sy'n cyfannu sawl genre ac sy'n defnyddio electroneg yn eang i greu perfformiadau unigryw.

Mae Ben wedi perfformio yn Brasil, Canada, y Caribî, Croatia, Gweriniaeth Tsieci, Ffrainc, Hwngari, Yr Eidal, Yr Iseldiroedd a Sbaen. Yn nes i adref, mae Ben wedi perfformio fel unawdydd yng Ngwyl Delyn Rhyngwladol Caeredin, Gwyl Delyn Rhyngwladol Cymru, Gwyl Delyn yr Haf, Gwyl Mynwy, Gwyl Llwydlo, Gwyl Delyn Trinity, Gwyl Delyn Swydd Derby, Penwythnos Telyn Camac Caerdydd, Gwyl Delyn East Anglia, Gwyl Jazz Wall2Wall, Gwyl Jazz Caergrawnt, Harp on Wight, Ysgol Haf I'r Delyn gan Celf Glas ar Wy a Gwyl Jazz y Fro. Bydd perfformiadau eleni yn cynnwys Cynhadledd Telyn y Byd yn Hong Kong, Penwythnos Telyn Pop a Jazz New Orleans, a pherfformiadau ac addysg u ar draws Tennessee, UDA. Bydd Ben yn rhuddhau ei drydydd album stiwdio (1 Man Band) yn Chwefor 2017 a bydd yn perfformio a recordio gydag Adrien Chevalier a Tatiana Eva Marie, aelodau o Fand Jazz Avalon o Efrog Newydd.



Deborah Henson-Conant, known as 'DHC', is a Grammy-nominated electric harp virtuoso with a wicked sense of humour, a gutsy set of vocal chords and a theatrical flair. Her decades-long career as composer, performer and creative coach, is one of constant invention and reinvention and collaboration with symphonies, innovators and theatres to create new works and a new instrument, the 'DHC' electric body harp developed in collaboration with Camac Harps. A fiercely independent innovator, DHC has created her own path, composing musical theatre since the age of 12, learning classical harp in her early 20's, becoming the world's pre-eminent jazz harpist in her 30's, composing and premiering alternative harp concertos in her 40's, touring with a rock band in her 50's – and finally synthesizing virtuosity, improvisation and story into her own genre of impassioned original solo musical theatre. She is founder and creator of 'Hip Harp Academy' – an international online academy with a full-year curriculum in improvisation and creative repertoire development – and of 'Harness Your Muse', her group mentorship program for creative and career development. Mae Deborah Henson-Conant, a adwaenir fel 'DHC', yn bencampwraig ar y delyn drydan, wedi ei henwebu am Grammy a chanddi hiwmor direidus, llais cryf a dawn theatrig. Mae ei gyfra ddegawdau oed fel cyfansoddwraig, perfformwraig, ac hyfforddwraig creadigol, yn un o greu newyddbathau, alegre parhaus gyda cherddorfeiddyd symffoni, arloeswyr a theatrau i greu gweithiau newydd ac offeryn newydd, y delyn corff trydan 'DHC' a ddatblygyd mewn cydweithrediad â Telynau Camac. Mae DHC yn ddyfeiswraig annibynnol benderfynol ac wedi creu ei llwybr ei hun, gan dddechrau cyfansoddi theatr gerdd yn 12 oed, dysgu'r delyn glasurol yn ei 20au cynnar, dod yn delynores jazz fydd-ewrog yn ei 30au, cyfansoddi a pherfformio consierts amgen i'r delyn yn ei 40au, teithio gyda band roc yn ei 50au - ac yn y pen draw yn cyfannu meistrolaeth, gweithiau byrfyfyr a stori i'w genre ei hun o theatr gerdd unigol wreiddiol angerddol. Hi yw sylfaenydd a chreadawdr 'Hip Harp Academy' - academi ar-lein rhyngwladol gyda chwricwlwm blwyddyn lawn ar chwarae'n fyrfyfyr a datblygu rhestr gweithiau creadigol- a 'Harness Your Muse', ei rhaglen mentorau grŵp ar gyfer datblygu gyrrfa a chreadigaeth. Tara Minton is a jazz harpist, vocalist and songwriter from Melbourne, Australia. She relocated to London in 2011 and has since carved out a career as one of the most innovative harpists in contemporary music. At home in the UK Tara has played concerts at Ronnie Scott's Upstairs, The Pizza Express Dean St, The Pheasantry, Brasserie Zédel, The Hidden Rooms, the Cambridge Jazz Festival and the London Eye! Tara's love for adventure lends itself to a life on the road and she tours regularly with her band, performing and conducting workshops in jazz harp and improvisation. So far, Tara has played shows in Ireland, Poland, Lithuania, Switzerland, France, Italy and Australia. Thanks to Camac Harps teaming Eleanor up with Deborah Henson-Conant for a creative project in Caernarfon, April 2010, Eleanor not only got the taste for electro-acoustic performing but also started a dynamic new phase in her career. An increase in confidence and freedom led to Eleanor's Wild Bird show, as well as performances in New Orleans (with the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra) and Sydney (at the World Harp Congress) under the baton of Deborah Henson-Conant herself! Eleanor loves to teach and share her experience with her students at Birmingham Conservatoire. She blends spoken word and dance with the harp, as well as composing music for concert, radio and theatre. Eleanor's current musical adventure - a collaboration with Balandino Di Donato: The Wood and The Water for electric harp, sound spatialisation and the Myo gesture-controlled armband - is, as its name suggests, perpetually evolving.
